SOCIETY TERMS & INFORMATION

To secure your reservation booking forms should be returned within 14 days together with a non-refundable deposit of £100, which will be offset against the final invoice.

Final numbers must be confirmed at least 48 hours prior to the visit. Any shortfall on these numbers on the day will result in a penalty of £20 per player being charged. Any shortfall of those dining only will be charged £10 per person.

All Society players must use the Visitors Car Park, which is clearly signposted.

The security code for entry can be obtained from the pro shop or before the day from the office.

On arrival the organiser must report to the General Manager's office to settle the account. Should you tee off before the office opens at 8.30am, payment must be received after your round. Individual cheques are not acceptable. If you wish to pay by credit card a 3% surcharge will be added to your final invoice. The office is up the stairs to the right inside the main entrance.

The Clubhouse opens at 7.00 a.m. The restaurant will open earlier when coffee and bacon rolls are required in the morning. The bar opens at 11.00 a.m.

If a Starter is allocated to your society, his instructions must be complied with at all times. He will inform players of any Local Rules in force, and ensure that the requisite standards of dress are met.

Buggies and trolleys are available through the Pro Shop by booking them in advance on 01628 523017.

Format of Play:

Generally Two/Three ball matches – Foursomes and Greensomes are allowed but four-ball play or any form of Texas Scramble is not permitted.

Play is off the Yellow Tees. Play may be granted off the Blue Tees on all society members producing handicap certificates with a CONGU Handicap of 22 or below.

Nearest the Pin and Longest Drive markers together with a tape measure are available. Please advise the Club in advance if these are required.

The Clubhouse has full changing facilities but towels are not provided.

The use of mobile telephones is prohibited in the bar/dining area and on the course except for emergencies.



Please make sure the members of your society are aware that public footpaths cross over parts of the course and players must wait until members of the public using these paths are out of range before playing.

Slow Play

Slow Play spoils everyone's enjoyment of the game, please put your faster players off first and ensure those following keep up with them.

Dress

GOLF SHOES must be worn on the Course but must not be worn in any area of the Clubhouse except the changing room. Please note that **we do not recommend the use of soft spikes, especially in damp / wet conditions.**

Trainers, hooded sweatshirts and any denim clothing are prohibited on the course. Shirts must have collars and be tucked in at all times, unless they are specifically tailored to be worn outside trousers, and hang just below the belt line. Trousers should not be tucked into socks. Baseball caps and any other headgear must be removed when in the Clubhouse.

Shorts may be worn whilst playing and in the Clubhouse before play (including lunch time). Shorts must be tailored (not sports shorts) and approximately knee length, and may only be worn with predominately white socks.

In inclement weather, players would be expected to change before entering the Bar or Dining Room.

The Organiser is to ensure that all members of the society understand course etiquette and comply with the Rules of Golf, and the Club, and is responsible for their standard of play and behaviour on the Course and in the Clubhouse.

All divots should be replaced, pitch marks correctly repaired and bunkers raked – please leave the course as you would like to find it.

Security

The Club will not be responsible for any items left unattended in the Car Park or Locker/Dressing rooms. The Club does not accept any liability for injury, loss or damage to persons or their property whilst on the Golf Course, in the Clubhouse or other areas of the grounds. We recommend that all participants have personal golf insurance cover.



Please do not leave valuables in the changing room and ensure your golf clubs are secure at all times. Holdall lockers are available.

The Course is closely bordered by residential and business premises in some areas. Any player striking a ball out of bounds is required to report the fact to the Secretary or Steward, and all players are advised to ensure that they are covered by insurance for causing accidental damage or injury, as the Club's insurance policy does not cover all such events. Societies will be charged for any damage caused by their members.
